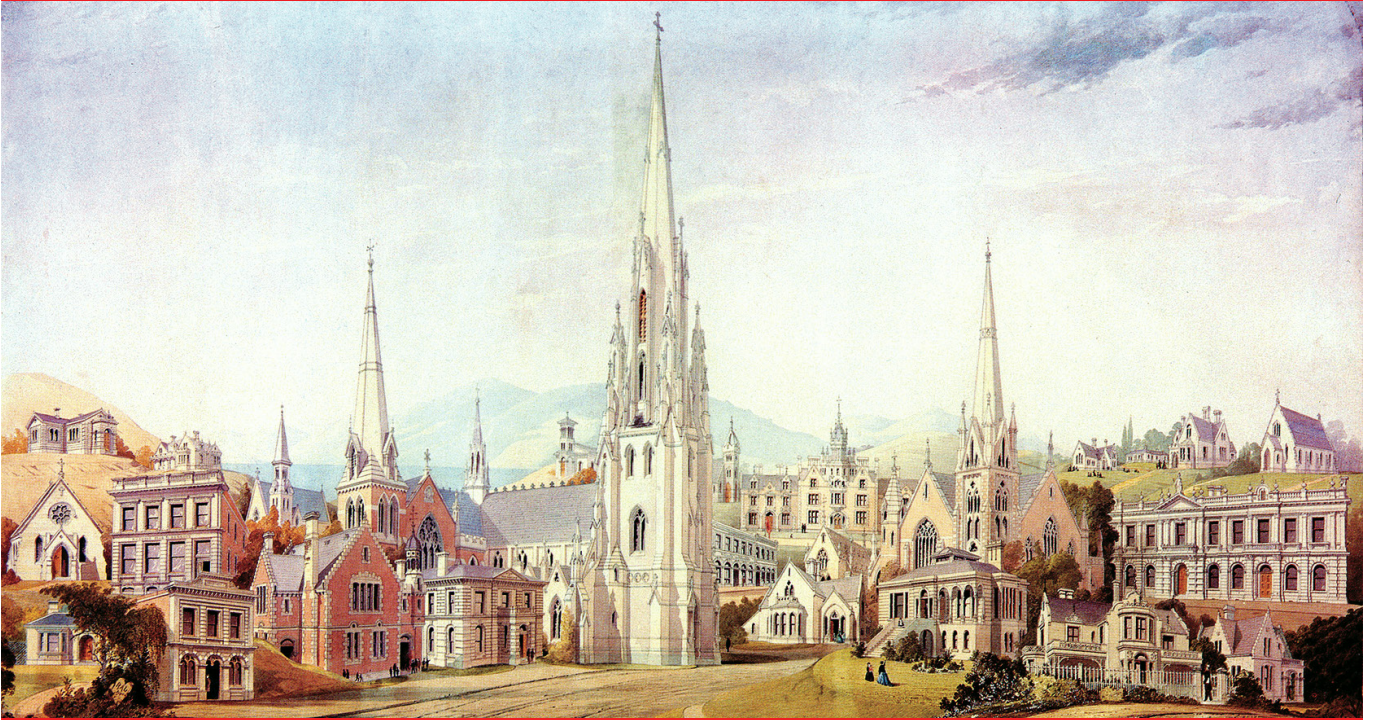

**PROFESSOR MURRAY RAE**, Theology Programme, University of Otago will talk on Dunedin churches – some of the greatest architectural buildings in the city. Introduced by **Professor Sir David Skegg**, former Vice-Chancellor of the University of Otago, Professor Rae will take us on a visual tour of a selection of Dunedin churches and explore the architectural means by which our forebears testified to their faith in God. He will also consider how that faith has been expressed anew in the renovation and updating of some of Dunedin's church buildings. Professor Rae's talk will be followed by a choral presentation by **Knox Church Children's Choir**, and a superb afternoon tea courtesy of the Dunedin Public Art Gallery Society. Background entertainment will consist of a visual presentation of photographs of churches provided by the Dunedin Public Art Gallery, Hocken Library, and Toitu Otago Settlers Museum.
