



Comprehension of hazard warning labels for consumer products

Research Participants Needed – aged 65+ years

We are seeking participants for a study examining the effectiveness of warning labels for common consumer products that are potentially hazardous (e.g., potting mix, bleach).

Research participants will be asked to view different warning labels and describe their impressions of each, including the potential hazards or risks conveyed by the label.
