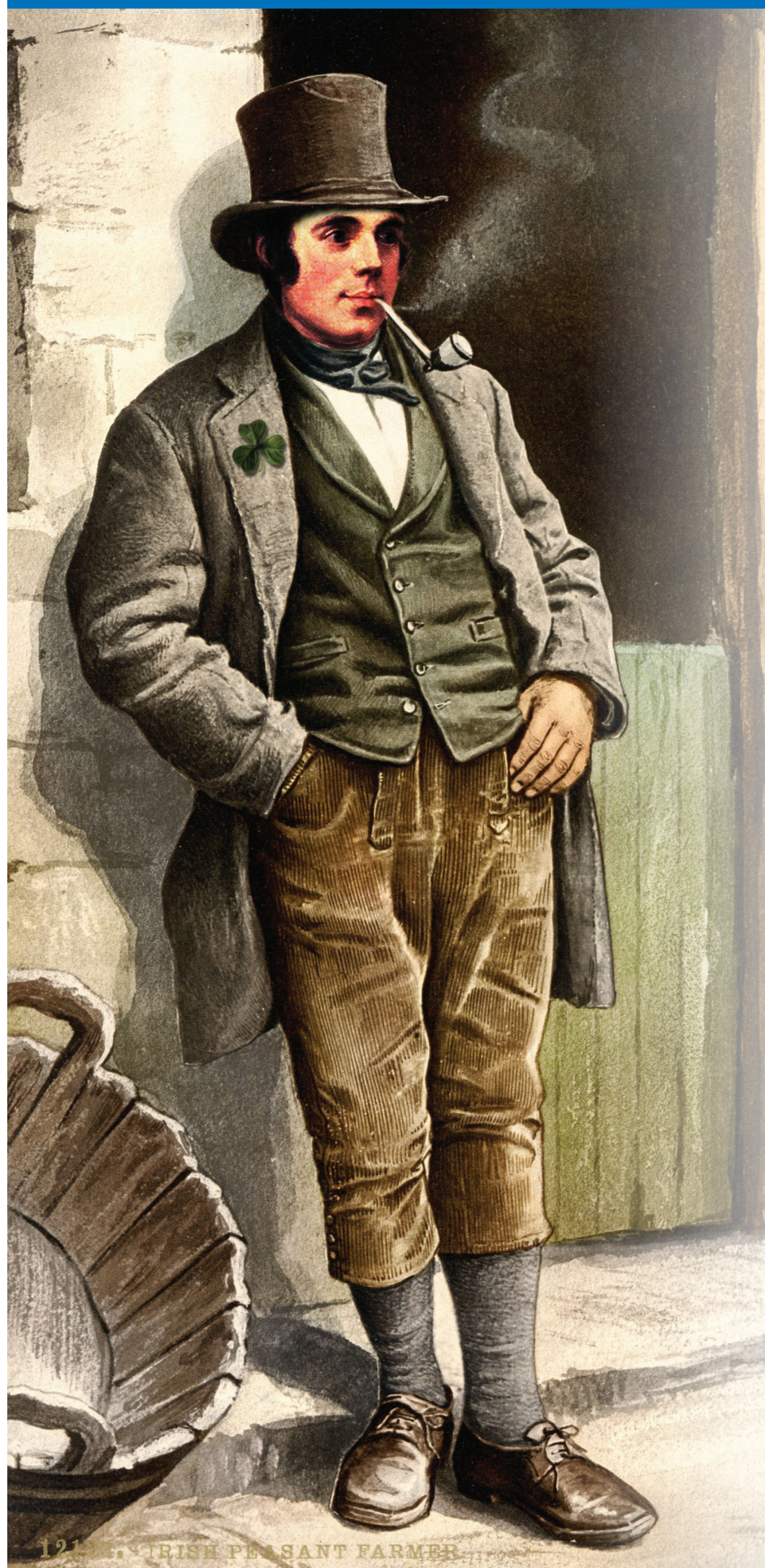


BURNS NIGHT DINNER 2021
