

Accessing the slides after Presentations

Slides are collected at the end of a week and posted over the weekend.

To see the slides:

- Log in as a member,
- Look at “Courses and Resources” in the left hand column of the web page,
- Click on that link to go to the list of courses in the current series,
- You will see (in green) “Associated documents for F” (or whatever the letter is appropriate to the course you are taking).
- Clicking on the green text will take you to a list of the different lectures for which resources are available.

To see what is available for a course you took in the last series, look at the far right of the web page and you will see (in blue) “Details of past courses”. Following that link will take you on quite a journey.

NOTE:

- **If, when you click on one of the presentations, nothing *seems* to happen, the chances are that the document has been SAVED into your “Downloads” folder.**
- **Have a look there in the first instance.**
- **There is an option in web browsers to either SAVE or OPEN the documents when clicked on.**
